A special raffle limited to 500 tickets (with advance ticket sales) for a 12 gauge Remington 870 Express Wingmaster, and an on-site raffle with many prizes the day of the Hunt.

In March each LLHRC member will receive in the mail 5 shotgun tickets to sell before the Hunt. The shotgun tickets will sell for \$5 each, and the winner need not be present. Of course, additional tickets will be available for those who want to sell more.

Can you train your dog on public land?

A typical training event: Your retriever is on heel and off leash as your daughter fifty yards away throws a dummy into knee high grass, at your command the dog runs a straight line to the mark, retrieves the dummy, returns on a straight line to heel and delivers to hand. It's the goal every hunting retriever owner/trainer keeps working at, the communication and control between dog and handler.

Now if this event takes place on public land are you also violating the law? It could be a leash law that interrupts your training session, or maybe nesting season restrictions or another regulation. Just what are the rules, regulations and laws about training on public land? Are there public lands where training is allowed or encouraged? Is there a public space in Minnesota where Hunt Tests can be run?

At our February meeting the LOLHRC decided to write to the MN DNR to see if there is public land where we or another retriever club could hold a Hunt or a Training Day. These concerns and issues will be discussed at future meetings, in the newsletter, at training days, and in our conversations with fellow retriever folks. Let's start the research and sharing of information with the hope that we'll all hear more about this concern.
